

## **THE FIXER**

### CONCEPT

Powerful people don't call the police when their careers are about to collapse, they call Marcus Cole.

A crisis fixer who protects elite clients before their scandals ever reach the public, Marcus doesn't seek justice. He contains damage.

### THE WORLD

A hidden network of political and corporate power where reputation is currency and information is leverage.

Behind closed doors, scandals are negotiated long before they ever surface, and the people controlling the narrative decide who survives, and who disappears.

### PROTAGONIST - MARCUS COLE

Calm, observant, and emotionally controlled, Marcus understands what people are truly afraid of losing, and uses it to stabilize crises.

But every situation he fixes pulls him deeper into morally grey territory, forcing him to question whether he's preventing chaos... or maintaining it.

### OPPOSITION - EVELYN ROSS

Strategic and quietly ruthless, Evelyn doesn't hide information, she weaponizes it.

Where Marcus tries to contain instability, she sees opportunity. Their relationship becomes a constant psychological power shift, where control is never guaranteed.

### SERIES ENGINE

Each episode centers on a career-threatening crisis threatening to expose a powerful client.

Marcus is brought in to contain the situation—but every solution creates new leverage, shifting alliances and destabilizing the system behind the scenes.

### SEASON ONE

Marcus begins believing he operates outside the system he protects.

But as patterns emerge, he realizes the crises he's fixing may not be accidental, and that the people hiring him might be orchestrating them.

By the end of the season, Marcus is forced to confront a deeper truth:

He may not be controlling the system—he may already be part of it.

SERIES OVERVIEW

The Fixer explores what happens behind the scenes when power is protected at all costs.

As the stakes rise, Marcus becomes increasingly entangled in the system he once believed he could remain separate from, until the line between control and complicity disappears entirely.
